
## In person school option




In the spring my school closed because of coronavirus.



Coronavirus is a virus that can make people sick, kind of like the flu. Kids don't usually get sick from this virus.




It is very contagious, which means it spreads easily from one person to another.

Scientists and doctors have said that wearing a mask can help keep our germs from spreading. Not that kind of mask!




No, not that kind either.




And definitely not that kind of mask!




Yes, that kind of mask, the kind that doctors and nurses wear.






Some people wear a face shield, which is like a wind shield for your face. It also keeps germs from spreading.




Now it's time for school to start back. Many schools are giving families choices about how they want to go back to school.



Some will be in a regular classroom in a school building, because that's what works best for their families.




Others will do school from home on the computer, because that's what works best for their families.




I will be doing school in a classroom with other students.

Scientists and doctors say that staying 6 feet apart is a good way to stop germs from traveling between people.




That's about the distance of 6 basketballs between us, or we could imagine a car between us.

especially when he/she needs to be close to me to help me with something.




Sometimes masks make it a little harder to hear someone speaking, so it will be important for me to listen carefully to my teacher.

We will still get to play and have P.E.




My teacher will still read to me, and we will play games.
